The Sudbury Right to Life Committee is preparing for the 20th National March for Life being held on Parliament Hill in Ottawa on Thursday, May 11, 2017. At least 2 Coach buses will depart from Sudbury at 6 a.m. and return the same night around 9:30 p.m.

A bus will leave from the parking lot of Ste-Anne-des-Pins Church and the other from Tim Hortons in Val Caron. A stop for more passengers is planned in Sturgeon Falls (7:00 a.m.) and another in North Bay (around 7:30 a.m.). Everyone must bring a bagged lunch and dinner. A restroom stop is planned near Pembroke.

Last year, approximately 25,000 people attended the event. This year, on the occasion of Canada's 150th anniversary, we hope to be even more. Come and join me as we make this trip to Ottawa. May we have a great turn out to show our Government that we need to defend the life of those who have no voice, from the moment of conception to natural death.
