What Happens at the Children's Liturgy?

Children are Welcomed & we begin with an Opening Prayer
The First Reading is Proclaimed.

The Psalm is then sung by the children often accompanied by clapping or some other form of activity. Alleluia is sung with actions.

The leader proclaims the Gospel and a reflection based on the reading is given.

The Creed is then proclaimed followed by the Prayers of the Faithful.

Children are escorted back to the assembly to join their families.

What Do You Need to Know?

- † Your children are in good hands!
- † All volunteers have been screened and have provided criminal record checks.
- † Children are always escorted to and from the assembly.
- † There is always a team of three adults present to assist with any concerns.
- † We will always treat your child as a gift from God—which they are!
