

Christmas & New Year's Mass Schedule

Christmas Eve—Thursday, 24 December

5:00 PM ~ 8:00 PM ~ 12:00 MIDNIGHT

Incense will be used at 8 PM & Midnight Masses

Doors Open 1 Hour Prior to Masses

A simultaneous mass will be celebrated in the parish hall at all mass times. The 5:00 PM mass will be live-streamed as well as being made available afterwards on our website for viewing at your convenience.

Please arrive as a family unit if you wish to sit together.

Seating can not be "saved" for others.

Once the Cathedral and Parish Hall are full, due to social-distancing protocols, all others will be gently turned away. We cannot add additional seating or have people standing in the Cathedral or Hall.
