Education and Awareness

*Did you know L.I.P.I – **Low Income People Involvement** of Nipissing offers the following programs?*

- **Household Stabilization Program** - helps Nipissing District residents who are experiencing homelessness or at-risk of homelessness by providing direct benefit support and navigation services.
- **Energy Assistance Program** - If you're behind on your electricity or natural gas bill and face having your service disconnected, you may qualify for emergency financial help through the Low-income Energy Assistance Program (LEAP).
- **Denture Assistance Program** - for individuals throughout the Nipissing District that cannot access existing support programs or require partial funding to pay for dentures.
- **Essential Health Program** - for individuals throughout the Nipissing District that cannot access existing support programs or require partial funding to pay for health-related items or services.
- **Dental Assistance Program** - for individuals throughout the Nipissing District that cannot access existing support programs or require partial funding to pay for emergency dental assistance.
- **Recreation and Community Program** - is both a family and individual support program for youth throughout the Nipissing District that cannot access existing support programs or require partial funding to pay for recreational, arts, culture and community activities. This program allows families to meet their household needs (rent, utilities, food etc.) without neglecting their children's social needs.
