In the first reading, Amaziah tries to move the prophet Amos away from the royal temple. Saint Paul praises God for his adoption of all people *to himself through Jesus Christ*. In Mark's Gospel, Jesus sends the Twelve out in pairs, giving them instructions on how to approach their ministry with simplicity. In the first reading and the Gospel, Amos and the Apostles are sent to convey God's perfect message, which tends to make sinners feel uneasy. Like Amos, confronting sin may not have been on our original to-do list. But how else can we open our hearts to receive the grace to boldly go forth to share the Good News to all who might listen?

They work around the clock organizing clothing and other items, reaching out and doing wellness checks, and finding campsites to Make sure everyone is safe, fed and taken care of.

Did you know that the Compassionate Committee for the Homeless in North Bay is starting a new initiative called **Backpacks of Love**? Since the last point-in-time count conducted in North Bay over two years ago, there were approximately 293 brothers and sisters who were homeless.
