The process of reconciliation requires truth-telling, deep listening, time, courage and a desire to know and understand others who are different from oneself.

You are invited to participate in this program being offered via zoom from the Faith and Justice Office of the Sisters of St. Joseph of Sault Ste. Marie. The Ltiv website above gives you information on each of the 11 sessions in the book. Since a book is required, I will order what we need and you can purchase one from me.

Last year's participants attended sessions 1 through 4, so we will begin with session 5: Ties of Kinship. The sessions are independent, not necessarily consecutive, so you need not have attended last year. However, you will be encouraged to study the first four chapters on your own as time goes on.

The schedule of online sessions via the Faith and Justice Office is attached. The sessions are monthly except in September. The Sept. 19 session is an introduction. On Sept. 26 we will work on chapter 5.
