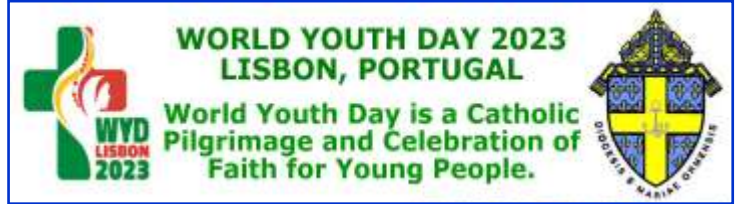

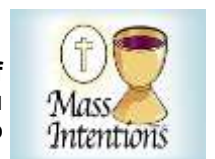

**The Catholic Community of
Volunteers is back in the hospital.**



The availability of the Eucharist to patients is on Wednesday, Friday and Sundays. In order to receive Eucharist, a patient must be identified as Catholic (usually at time of admission) and *the patient or family member must authorize the visitation of a volunteer.*

Due to privacy and confidentiality regulations, volunteers do not have access to patient lists to know what patients are Catholic and who may wish to receive Eucharist. You must identify as a member of the Catholic Community and ask for Eucharist.

If someone is not already on the visitation list, they or a family member can contact Deacon Rick Hamelin at 705-476-8115 or Hospital Chaplain Services at 705-491-0318 to arrange to receive the Eucharist.
