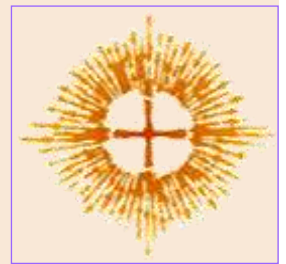

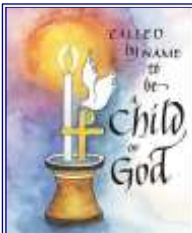
Ice Cream Sunday in support of our Youth Trip!

 Amen

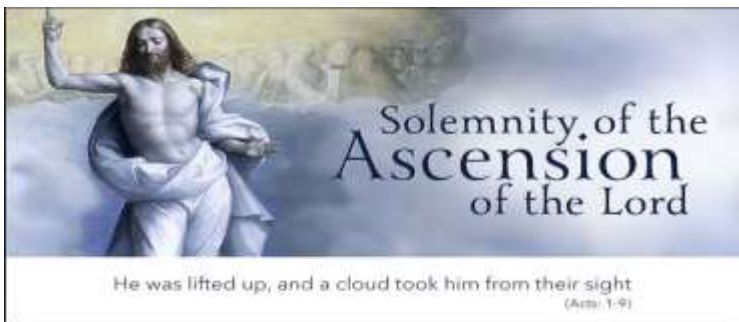
