



Daniel sees a vision of the *Son of man* coming on the clouds, and his kingship will not be destroyed. In the second reading, Jesus is the ruler of *the kings of the earth*, and he has made us a kingdom of priests. He is coming amid the clouds for all to see. In the Gospel, Jesus tells Pilate that his kingdom does not belong to this world. Today's solemnity, by which we close the liturgical year, reminds us that Christ is king and ruler of all. He is the firstborn of the dead in whom all power and authority has been invested. By our baptism we share in that holy and royal identity so that we might witness to his glory and kingship before the world.
