FIRST GATHERING coming up January 26

The celebration of First Reconciliation will be held March 26, 2025 and First Communion will be held on June 1, 2025.

Please pre-register your child now and correspondence will be sent to you at a later date regarding preparation gatherings. The on-line registration form can be found on our website under SACRAMENTS under both Eucharist and Reconciliation. Children who have already celebrated Baptism are welcome to register. To register for First Communion, children should be baptized and have already celebrated First Confession.
