In the first reading Peter is arrested, but prayer is made on his behalf and he is rescued by the *angel of the Lord*. In the second reading, Paul tells Timothy that he is being *poured out like a libation* and that he has *finished the race*. In the Gospel, Peter responds to Jesus' question about his identity by saying, *You are the Christ, the Son of the living God*. Jesus declares that he will give Peter the keys to the kingdom of heaven. While preaching and spreading the Gospel after the Resurrection, Peter was arrested by King Herod. Meanwhile, *prayer by the Church was fervently being made to God on his behalf*. The early Church offers us an example of intercessory prayer that we should imitate by praying fervently for the successor of Peter, the pope.
