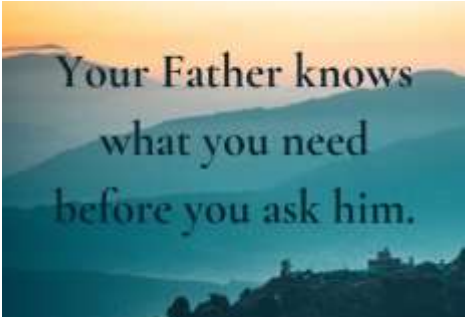

Welcome to Your Father's House!

In the first reading, the Lord promises Abraham and Sarah a son after they show abundant hospitality to their guests. In the second reading, Paul writes that he rejoices in his sufferings because he finds hope in Christ. In the Gospel, Martha becomes frustrated with Mary for not helping her serve Jesus. Jesus responds that Mary *has chosen the better part*. The Liturgy of the Word today highlights God's goodness through generosity. From blessing Abraham and Sarah with their long-awaited child to assuring Martha that she need not worry, the Lord knows our deepest needs and responds to them. May we model this compassionate response in all our relationships.
