The prophet Amos warns those who take advantage of others that the Lord will remember their actions. In his Letter to Timothy, Paul asks that people should pray for everyone, including rulers and those in authority, for God wishes all to be saved. Today's readings invite us to reflect on our relationship with money and wealth in light of our faith in God.
