The 15th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year A invites us to think about how God’s word works in our lives. Each reading uses simple images from the world around us. Rain, seeds, soil, and harvest all show how God’s word brings life and hope. We are reminded that God always works with purpose. In Isaiah, we hear how God’s word is like rain that makes the earth fruitful. Paul tells us in Romans that creation itself longs for freedom and shares in our hope. In the Gospel, Jesus uses the parable of the sower to teach us that our hearts must be ready to receive God’s word.

This Sunday, these passages come together to remind us that God’s plan is certain. His word nourishes us, even when life feels dry or hard, God keeps working. His word brings hope and promise to the world. Faith grows best in hearts that are ready and patient. We are called to listen, trust, and stay open. When we do, and with open hearts, we can grow strong in faith and bear much fruit.
